1. Your opinion on the task-based learning/assessment procedure (strong points, weak points, suggested changes)

I think that the task-based homework has been very useful in the sense that I have been able to contribute in class while talking about the play, because I had already done some research on it. I also think that the assessment has been the adequate for this course. However, for my part, considering my working situation, I think there are too many tasks and I have not been able to complete all the tasks (the first version) the best possible way. Yet, I have really liked working on so many plays to have a great knowledge of contemporary British theatre.

2. Your opinion on your own learning process (how much do you think you have learnt, both in terms of contents and learning procedures? How do you value what you have learnt?)

I think that the content of the course is very well selected in relation to the plays, the theoretical information and secondary sources. However, as I have commented above, I wish I had had more time to work on it. In any case, I have learnt a lot and I have really enjoyed the lessons and the way they were handled. I strongly consider that all the knowledge I have acquired in this course will be of great value for my future career.

3. Your opinion on the plays we have been working on (strong points, weak points, suggested changes)

I think that the selection of the plays has been adequate for the topics we were dealing with in class. I had only read *Pornography* before starting the course, so I have discovered new plays which, again, contribute to my understanding of contemporary British theatre.

4. Your opinion on the secondary materials we have used (strong points, weak points, suggested changes)

I think that the secondary materials have been very useful both for the writing of the tasks and for the oral presentation, at least mine. The fact of having many materials to approach the plays has been very helpful in order to understand them. However, as I have mentioned above, sometimes I did not have time to read all the materials posted in the campus.
