1. Take off: enlairar-se vs landed: aterrar; runway: pista d'aeroport; to taxi: rodar (avió); to touch down: tocar terra.

2. Give sb a lift: portar en cotxe algú a algun lloc; pick sb up: recollir algú d'algun lloc; drop sb off: deixar algú a algun lloc; see sb off: acomiadar-se d'algú que marxa de viatge.

3. Have a rest: descansar; enjoy always requires a direct object, in this case, a personal reflexive pronoun. In contrast, relax NEVER takes a direct object or reflexive pronoun. Unwind /ʌn'waɪnd/: desconnectar, relaxar-se.

4. Delay: retard; board: pujar a bord.

5. To put sb up: allotjar algú durant un període breu de temps gratis; stay x time: passar 'x' temps a algun lloc o amb algú.

6. Trip: viatge curt; journey: travessia, viatge llarg; tour = ruta; travel: incomptable quan es refereix a 'trànsit'; comptable quan es refereix a 'trajectes'.
