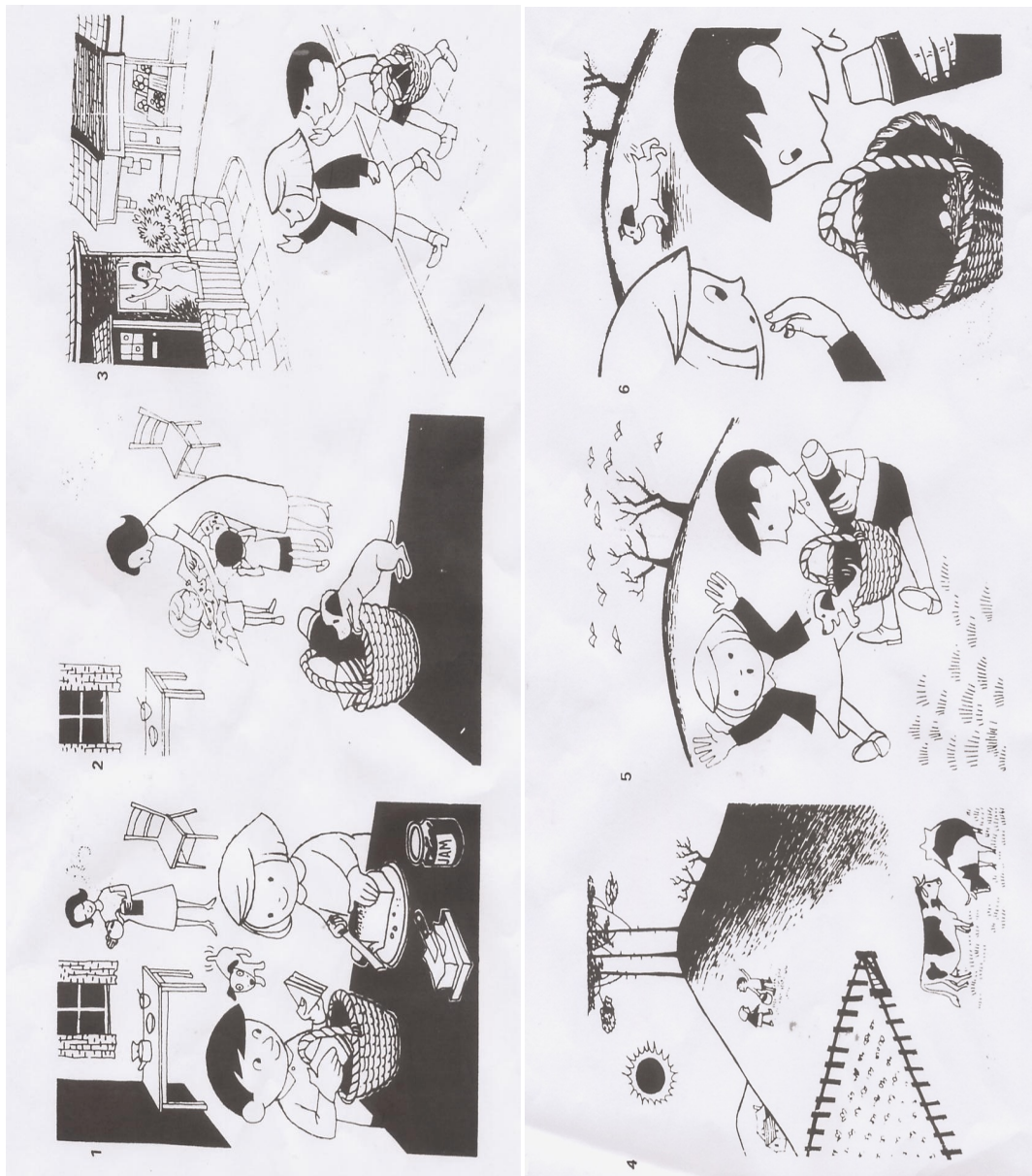
A.3.2 Storytelling
