ABOUT THE LIBRARY

The Mundet Campus Library opened in 1995 and covers a total area of 3,865 sq m, spread over two floors. It houses specialized materials that support teaching and research linked to the courses of study taught at the faculties of Education and Psychology.

Equipment and facilities

The Library has 771 reading desks, 49 computers, a training room housing 21 computers, wireless internet access and access to the Eduroam network, 8 individual or group study rooms, 2 mailboxes for returning documents, 7 laptops for loan, 1 self-loan machine, and audio and DVD equipment. Users with a visual impairment also have access to ZoomText and Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA) screen reading software and also to a Luxo FL-101 reading light. Each area of the Library is marked with its designated noise level.

Who can use the Library?

Anyone can consult the collection. To borrow books and other items and to access other services you will need the UB card you are issued at the time of enrolment. Our library staff will help you to activate your card.

Cercabib and My account

Cercabib is the CRAI's discovery tool. You can use it to search simultaneously through the entire CRAI collection, regardless of document format, type or location.

From My account, located on the search page of Cercabib, you can manage your loans and renew and reserve items.
