The **Mundet Campus Library** was opened in 1995 and covers a total area of 3,865 sq m, spread over two floors. It houses specialized materials that support teaching and research linked to the courses of study taught at the faculties of Education and Psychology.

Equipment and facilities

The library has 750 reading desks, a training room with 20 computers, 44 additional computers, wireless internet access and access to the Eduroam network, 6 group study rooms, 4 photocopiers connected to public-use computers for printing (2 with scanners and 2 with USB ports), 4 scanners, 1 self-loan machine, and audio and DVD equipment. Users with visual impairments also have access to ZoomText screen reading software and Luxo FL-101 reading lights.

Who can use the Library?

Anyone can consult the collection. To loan books and other items and to access other services you will need the **UB card** you are issued at the time of enrolment. **Library staff will help you activate your card.** Remember that it will need to be renewed each academic year.

• Laptop loans
