





### UNIVERSITAT DE BARCELONA

Founded in 1450, the University of Barcelona is this year commemorating its 575th anniversary. It continues to set a benchmark for quality in education, science and knowledge and remains committed and accountable to wider society. The UB's status as a leading higher education institution, recognized by numerous external organizations and bodies, is grounded in quality and innovation in teaching, research, good governance and ethical integrity, as well as the integration of social responsibility into all its areas of activity.

The new Statute of the UB, drafted through a participatory process involving the entire university community, is currently being finalized. It will provide a modern legal framework for the institution that aligns perfectly with the needs of the present, as well as projecting the University into the future and bolstering its role as a key driver of development and social transformation.

The UB is also moving forward in the area of infrastructures, in particular as it continues to roll out the Diagonal Health Axis project. Encompassing the new UB Clínic Health Campus, the new Faculty of Pharmacy and the MIES initiative, the Diagonal Health Axis will become the most important hub for research, knowledge and clinical care in Europe, providing a nexus for collaboration between the UB and leading health institutions such as the Clínic, Bellvitge and Sant Joan de Déu hospitals.

As a research institution, the UB continues to achieve outstanding results, securing total funding in excess of 200 million euros and registering 7,768 scientific publications. In the area of studies, the broad and multidisciplinary course offering has again attracted an exceptionally large number of learners, with total student numbers exceeding 60,000 this year.

This document provides a detailed overview of the main activities carried out over the course of the 2024–2025 academic year in the areas of teaching, research, knowledge transfer and internationalization, as well as key data on the University's structure, activities and services.




