


Women in Science and Engineering in the EU

Share of women scientists and engineers by sector (EU, 2023)



Knowledge-intensive services: Activities that require highly qualified personnel. They generate and apply specialised knowledge.

- 2.67 million women scientists and engineers in the EU (2023)
- Only 22.3% in high-tech sectors
- Nearly 42% in knowledge-intensive services
- Under 25% in vehicle manufacturing
