Welcome to the Pavelló de la República!

The Municipality of Barcelona, Josep Maria Figueras and the University of Barcelona agreed, in 1994, to unite the bibliographic collections of the CEHI and the Biblioteca Figueras. A few years later, the two collections were transferred to the Pavelló de la República. As a result of the union, the library has become an international benchmark on the subjects of the Spanish Civil War, Second Spanish Republic, Exile, Franco Regime and the Transition to democracy, with a special emphasis on Catalonia.

Besides these main topics, the Library also holds a large collection of documents on the former the Soviet Union and the countries within its sphere of influence, 20th century international politics and especially the Second World War. Finally, it has a remarkable collection on 20th century economic history of Central and South America, consisting of books, journals and archive materials.

The library is open to everybody.

Monographs and leaflets

The collection comprises approximately 150,000 titles, many of which are rare.

Periodicals

More than 14,500 titles, ranging from the end of the 19th century to the present time, especially Spanish Civil War, Second Spanish Republic and exile. There is also a notable collection of political and trade union clandestine press of the Franco Regime and publications of neighbourhood associations, political parties and trade unions after they became legal.

Audio recordings

More than a hundred cassettes and CDs, ranging from Falange or Republican songs to speeches of politicians.

Video recordings

There are approximately 200 videos and DVDs.

Posters

There are more than 10,000 posters. About 3,000 of those date from the period of the Second Republic and the Civil War. 1,200 are digitalised and can be accessed on the UB catalogue and the Memòria Digital de Catalunya:

Stickers

The collection comprises some 15,000 stickers that correspond to political, economic, social and cultural events which have taken place in Catalonia and Spain from the Franco Regime to the present day.

🕨 Memorabilia

This collection is made up of flags, pennants, match boxes, cigarette lighters, insignias, and badges, all

created for propaganda purposes by different political parties, trade unions and cultural organizations.

Archive documentary collections

There are two archive collections, the collection of the CEHI and the collection of the Josep Maria Figueras Foudation, both are very similar in terms of the period they cover and their subject and format.

- *DH and F-DH. Historical Documents Series:* From 1850 to the end of the Spanish Civil War.
- *DO and F-DO. Exile Documents Series:* Documents written in exile.
- *FV and F-FV. Leaflet Series:* From 1939 to the present day
- FP and F-FP. Personal Documents Series: Comprises 113 personal files
- *AG and F-AG Graphic Archive Series:* Graphic material: pictures, postcards, calendars, paper money and stamps
- *DU University Series:* Related to universities and student movements in Catalonia and Spain from the Second Spanish Republic to the present day.
- *MAS Massip Archive:* Documents related basically to the PSUC in exile.
- *MIL Movimiento Ibérico de Liberación Archive:* Documents about the political and armed activities of this organization and its relationship with other freedom fighting groups.
- *AM Moscow Archive:* Documents from the KGB Archive in Moscow recording the role played by the Soviet Union in the Spanish Civil War
- *SA Salamanca Archive:* Documents of CNT and UGT from 1936-1938
